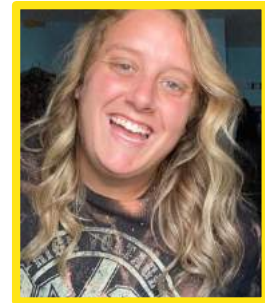

Some shows, films, and podcasts I've been consuming this month.

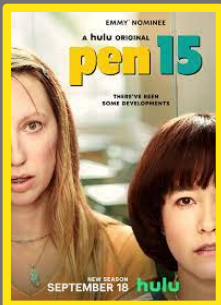


Promising Young Woman (2020)

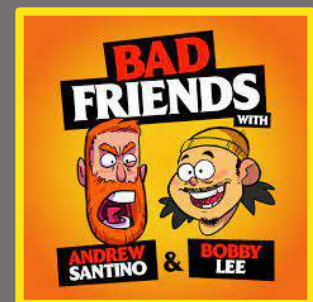
PEN15 (2019-?)
