Media Recommendations

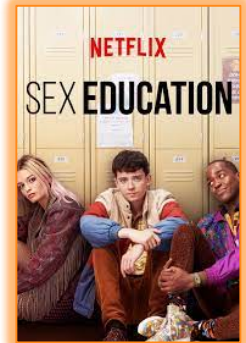
Some podcasts, shows, music, and movies that I've been consuming lately.

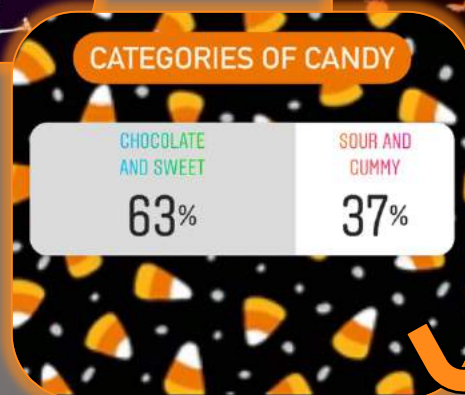

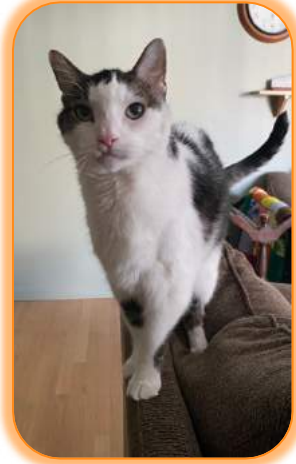
